Eye on Blindness is a half hour radio show produced by the Blind and Low Vision Services and Georgia Radio Reading Services (GaRRS). The show airs the last Wednesday of each month at 2 pm and the following Saturday at 10:30 am. The host of the show is Dick Edwards, a retired television broadcaster. The show presents topics about programs and services available to the visually impaired, as well as topics regarding research, technology, career options, and advice to inform and educate the radio listener.

The August 2006 show's guest will be Rebecca Sills, Coordinator– Deaf, Hard of Hearing, Deaf-Blind for the GA Dept. of Labor/Vocational Rehabilitation Services and Susan Lascek, Supervisor of Regional Reps for Helen Keller National Center.
